Details

- Your student must be enrolled in one or more of the above classes this year. Please verify that your student is currently enrolled in the course before applying.
- Register via the link provided below. You will be registering directly with the college.
- Dual enrollment will be open from November 1, 2024-February 4, 2025.
- To register, you will provide the student and parent contact information and student social security number.
- The cost is \$245 per course, paid via credit card. The college admissions office will not charge the credit card until the application closes in February.
- Students will receive an email confirmation which we suggest they save for future use such as ordering transcripts (more information below) **NOTE:** If no confirmation email is received registration has not been successful.
- Students should check with their teacher to learn what additional assignments they will need to complete to
 receive the dual enrollment credit. If there is an additional assignment, and that assignment is not completed,
 the student will not receive the college credit and the payment will not be refunded.
- Most colleges in the U.S. will accept these credits; many accept the Bible courses as religion or elective credits.
 To learn if a course transfers to a particular college and what type of credit would be received, please check the college's website or email their admissions dept. As an example, NC State posts it HERE.
- How is dual enrollment different from AP credit? To receive college credit for an AP course, most colleges require a score of 4 or 5 on the AP exam (sometimes a 3). Dual enrollment earns college credit (3 credit hours) for completing the course that is already being taken. A college transcript will be issued.
- If you completed a dual enrollment course in previous years and would like to order a copy of your transcript or
 to have it sent to a college, go here: <u>Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary Transcript Request | Parchment.</u>
 You will enter the student's social security number in place of a student ID. Please note that transcripts will not
 be provided until final grades for the course have been entered. So, you will not be able to receive a transcript
 for a course you are taking this year until June, after final grades are posted.
